Lake Maggiore: famous for being featured in American writer **Ernest Hemingway**'s novel *A Farewell To Arms*, it is the second largest lake in <u>Italy</u> and is also renowned for its marvellous gardens.

Your marriage will be celebrated in the astonishing **Villa San Remigio**, built at the beginning of the 20th century to embody the love between Neapolitan poet and musician Marquis **Silvio della Valle di Casanova** and Irish artist **Sofia Browne**. The magnificent Villa's garden will be the amazing background for your **wedding photo shoot** among fountains and statues, flowers and trees.

Lake Como: this lake has been a popular retreat for aristocrats and wealthy people since Roman times and is widely regarded as **one of the most beautiful lakes in Italy**. Your wedding can be organized in **Villa Cipressi**, an historic complex built between 1400 and 1800, which was restored in 1980 and transformed into a cozy hotel immersed in a centuries-old park. Bride and groom will have the opportunity to enjoy their wedding banquet here and spend the night in a wonderful room with the view on the Lake Como.
